

FIB-RUARY

We will discuss, define and dissect the meaning of fibbing and lying. Give them examples, express the dangers, share scriptures and stories from the Bible, but most of all share with them that **God** wants us to be honest.

In this first lesson we will focus on what a lie or fib is and be aware that God wants us to be honest.

Read the definition of a Lie from the Handout

Ask the kids if they have ever lied about going to school?
Have you ever made up a story like I don't feel good to get out school?
Have you ever pretended to be sick? (maybe give a personal story)
Does that Honor your Parents?

Read: Proverbs 6:16-19

What does the Bible say about lying?

Go over Hand-out "Top 10 lies kids tell their parents"

Have the kids discuss and share some of their stories

Read: John 8:43-47

Who is the Father of Lies?

Go over Handout of Honest Questions

(have pencils ready for the kids to write their answers)

Wrap it up with Colossians 3:9-10 and John 8:44

Who are you acting like?

Pray with the kids

Encourage the parents to go back over Handout with kids during the coming week.
